Purpose

To provide local health district mental health staff with an introduction to working with high risk civil or forensic patients in general community and inpatient mental health services. The program covers the key concepts of safe practice when working with high risk civil or forensic patients.

CRAM Program

The majority of the program covers knowledge and skill development in the area of Clinical Risk Assessment and Management (CRAM). The program also introduces participants to the forensic mental health system in NSW.

CRAM provides a framework for clinical risk assessment and management of patients and is valuable for all mental health clinicians. This training introduces concepts and practices integral to working with high risk civil and forensic patients and also covers the relationship between mental illness and violence. The CRAM program sets out a five-step process that clinicians can follow to assess patients' risk in an informed manner and develop comprehensive risk management plans.

This two-day workshop refers to the HCR-20 but does not cover the HCR-20 in depth.

HCR-20 Training

HCR-20 Version 3 training will be delivered as a separate two-day workshop. Attendance at the CRAM workshop is a prerequisite for HCR-20 training. Dates are as follows:
